The research was implemented using the online questionnaire in the pop-up format that was shown to randomly selected website users. Selection structure is corrected by weighing data by gender, age, region/city of the respondents.












Awareness of activities of civil society organizations and civic initiatives. Age and settlement type.

Accessibility of information about civil society organizations and civic initiatives


Rate accessibility of information about civil society organizations and civic initiatives on a five-point scale



What is your overall attitude towards activities of civil society organizations and civic initiatives?



Attitude towards activities of civil society organizations and civic initiatives. Age and settlement type


What is your overall attitude towards activities of civil society organizations and civic initiatives?

Young people aged 15-24 and inhabitants of cities over 500 thousands population have the most positive attitude.













Do you trust civil society organizations and civic initiatives?




Trust towards civil society organizations and civic initiatives. Age

Do you trust civil society organizations and civic initiatives? Please state your age






Trust towards civil society organizations and civic initiatives in different spheres

Do you trust civil society organizations and civic initiatives that work in the following spheres:





Attitude towards civil society organizations and civic initiatives: summing up responses

- 71% of respondents know about activities of civil society organization and civic initiatives in their settlement or region, but would like to know more (72%)
- 69% of respondents have a positive attitude towards activities of civil society organizations and civic initiatives, but only 57% trust them
- Young people aged 15-24 and inhabitants of cities with over 500 thousand people have the most positive attitude
- Respondents trust, most of all, civil society organizations and civic initiatives working in the spheres of animal protection and healthy lifestyle

- Deputies of various levels and local authorities are expected to be solving the problems (73 and 70% answers), but in practice the problems are solved by civil society organizations and citizens themselves (31 and 30% answers)
- 55% respondents think that civil society organizations must solve local problems, but just 33% have answered that they do, in reality
- Personal participation in events and reaction is social networks are the most important factors of evaluation of effectiveness of civil society organizations and civic initiatives activities




- 20% of respondents participate in the activities of civil society organizations and initiatives
- The most active respondents are aged 15-24 and 45-75

- Participation potential 3 times more (62% of answers)
- By type of employment, these are students, those who work more than 40 hours per week and those retired by age






Incentives and barriers for participation in civil society organizations and civic initiatives: summing up responses

- Main motives for participation: interesting projects, common values, desire to help others and clear goals of organizations and initiatives
- The importance of common values increases with age
- Men are more pragmatic: clarity of goals is somewhat more important for women, and helping those who have problems is more important for men

- The main barriers to participation in organizations and initiatives are lack of awareness of participation opportunities and lack of resources (time and competencies)
- The least informed about participation opportunities are the respondents aged 15-24



Engagement potential: areas of activity. Summary of responses


- The most in-demand areas of activity are ecology, healthy lifestyle, human rights
- For respondents aged 15-24, the five most important areas of activity ("very important" and "somewhat years business support; 45-54 charity; 55-74 Information.
- In rural areas and cities with less than 500 thousand inhabitants, culture and information are the top five in demand, and in cities over 500 thousand inhabitants business support

- Most of respondents are ready to participate in the activities of organizations and initiatives involved in ecology, healthy lifestyle, as well as sports, recreation, tourism.
- The greatest potential for participation is among residents of villages and small towns aged 15-24





Are you ready to participate in solving relevant problems of your local community (your district, village, street, home, etc.) through?














Willingness to financially support community service

Potential for engagement: types of activity. Summary of responses

- Actions and events the main form of participation
- 27% of respondents aged 15-24 are members of public organizations or civic initiatives
- At least 40% of those who know about the activities of organizations in their locality or region reported that they were members of organizations

- 51% of respondents are ready to be the initiators of specific actions; 78% are ready to help the initiatives of others
- There are more initiators of activity among respondents aged 15-44 years, with complete secondary and incomplete higher education, living in rural areas; these are students, those who work more than 40 hours a week and those who have not worked and not studied over the past year
- The most acceptable types of volunteer activities: gathering items and food products and Information; least at-home help and fundraising




AWARENESS

- 71% of respondents know about the activities of public organizations and civic initiatives in their locality and / or region,
- 72% would like to know more

IMAGE

- 69% of respondents have a positive attitude to the activities of civil society organizations and civics' initiatives, but only 58% trust them
- Respondents trust civil society organizations and initiatives in the sphere of the protection of animals and healthy lifestyle most of all
- 55% of respondents believe that civil society organizations and initiatives should solve local problems, but only 33% believe that this is happening
- Personal participation in events and reaction in social networks are the most important factors in assessing the effectiveness of civil society organizations and initiatives



READiness TO PARTICIPATE

ENGAGEMENT POTENTIAL

- 20% of respondents participate in the activities of civil society organizations and initiatives
- Participation potential is 3 times larger (62% of answers)
- Main incentives for participation: interesting projects, common values, the desire to help others and clear goals of organizations and initiatives
- The main barriers are lack of awareness of participation opportunities and lack of resources (time and competencies)
- The most in-demand areas of activity: ecology, healthy lifestyle, human rights

- In rural areas and cities with less than 500 thousand inhabitants, culture and information are in the top five in demand, and in cities over 500 thousand inhabitants business support
- The greatest potential for participation residents of villages and towns aged 15-24
- 51% of respondents are ready to be the initiators of civic activities; 78% are ready to help the initiatives of others
- There are more initiators among respondents aged 15-44, with complete secondary and incomplete higher education, living in rural areas; these are students, those who work more than 40 hours per week and those who have not worked and not studied over the past year
- The most acceptable types of volunteer activities: gathering items and food products and information distribution; least acceptable ones—home care and assistance, fundraising
